## **Ryan White**

The Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program is a government program that provides funds for health care and supportive services to people living with HIV.

- Emergency Financial Assistance
- Food Bank & Congregate Meals
- Health Education & Risk Reduction
- Health Insurance Premium and Cost-Sharing Assistance for Low Income Individuals
- Home and Community-Based Services
- Housing
- Language Services (Translation & Interpretation)
- Legal Services
- LGBTQ+ Support Services
- Medical Case Management, including Treatment Adherence
- Medical Transportation
- Mental Health Services
- Non-Medical Case Management
- Oral Health Care
- Outpatient/Ambulatory Health Services
- Outreach Services
- Psychosocial Support
- Referral for Healthcare and Supportive Services
- Substance Use Disorder Care (Outpatient)

### **To receive these services, you must:**

1. Live in Pennsylvania
2. Be living with HIV
3. And have a gross annual income of less than or equal to 500 percent of the Federal Poverty Level. As of January 2025, the income limits are:

Single Person:	\$78,250
+1:	\$105,750
+2:	\$133,250
+3:	\$160,750
+4:	\$188,250
